## Activity: Local Poverty in Hong Kong Website (3 lessons)

Create a website using to inform others about the Poverty Crisis affecting many families today in Hong Kong.

This website should address the: Who, What, When, Where, Why and How of the issue. See some ideas below. You may use the Weebly (<a href="https://www.weebly.com/hk?lang=en">https://www.weebly.com/hk?lang=en</a>) or any other similar online website builder.

Consider the following questions, but they are not exhaustive. You could come up with other questions:

- Who lives in poverty?
- What does it mean to live in poverty? What does poverty look like? What are some statistics
  (poverty line, poverty rate, poverty indicators, etc.; you may use the infographic activity data)
  associated with the issue?
- What is the situation of the working poor? The women? The elderly? N-nothing people? Ethnic minorities?
- When does poverty occur? When does one go from being economically stable to poverty?
- Where does poverty exist? Where can people go for help/assistance?
- Why do we need to be aware of this problem?
- What is a poverty cycle? How do we solve this problem?

Note: It's better to have different sections for different aspects of the issue. Be sure to save your progress along the way.
